GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (CLYDE WALKWAY, NATIONAL CYCLE ROUTE 75) (DALMARNOCK ROAD TO CAIRNCRAIG STREET) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER MARCH 2015

Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "Glasgow City Council (Clyde Walkway, National Cycle Route 75) (Dalmarnock Road to Cairncraig Street) (Temporary Closure) Order 2015" effective from 7th April 2015 until the Friday 30th October 2015, all dates inclusive.
- 2. This Order prohibits the use by vehicles and pedestrians as specified below (with the exception of those vehicles associated with the Construction of the bridge works on the undernoted length of road / walkway / cycle route.
- 3. The prohibitions shall apply where indicated by the display of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations.

Prohibitions

The use of:-

The Clyde Walkway, National Cycle Route 75; between the unnamed footpath to the east of Dalmarnock Bridge, connecting the Walkway and Dalmarnock Road at Dalmarnock Bridge, & the unnamed footpath (Formerly Cairncraig Street) connecting the Walkway and London Road at the west end of the former Belvedere Hospital site, is prohibited to all vehicles and pedestrians.

Diversions

The diversions required are local to the closure that will be in place and will be signposted as appropriate.
