

Councillor Ward Tour - Anniesland & Drumchapel

<i>Directions</i>	<i>Points to Note</i>
Start	Meet outside Drumchapel Cycle Hub, Drumchapel Sports Centre, 195b Drumry Road East.
Turn right into Drumry Road East	
Turn right at roundabout into Duntreath Avenue	Note lack of cycle facilities
Turn right at 2nd traffic signals into Allerdyce Road	Great Western Retail Park
Fork left at 3rd roundabout onto footway (dismounted)	
Cross Great Western Road at pedestrian crossing	Cross to shared use footway on far side of A82 Crossing could be converted to toucan crossing
Turn left onto Great Western Road (shared use footway)	This is in West Dunbartonshire but shows how nothing in Glasgow City Council's adjacent area links up for cycling
Stop at next signpost	The West Dunbartonshire shared use footway ends at the council boundary and cyclists are directed to the Forth & Clyde Canal via Linnvale (in West Dunbartonshire)
Continue straight on along Great Western Road footway (dismounted)	Note that the footway either side of the council boundary is identical but cycling is not permitted on the Glasgow side
Continue straight on along Great Western Road footway (dismounted)	Across two sliproads Dropped kerbs needed
Turn 1st right onto path to Forth & Clyde Canal	Immediately after flyover
Turn left at end onto Forth & Clyde Canal towpath	Note bumpy kerbs at Bard Avenue crossing
At Lock 35 detour over the canal.	View the garden planted by Sustrans/Green Gym volunteers including GoBike committee member, Alasdair Macdonald – volunteers required to extend and maintain the garden!
Continue along towpath	
Turn right onto path to Great Western Road	After Great Western Road bridge Note how signage does not mention where paths to the side go Note lack of path to opposite side of Great Western Road
Turn left at end into Great Western Road	Note lack of cycle facilities on very wide dual carriageway
Turn 5th left into	At Knightswood Cross

Baldwin Avenue	
Turn 1st right into Fulton Street	
At Knightscliffe Avenue	Veer to the left and into grounds of Netherton Community Centre
Turn left into Temple Walkway	Follow path past the Temple Swimming Baths, lying closed for approximately 20 years.
Continue straight on along path to Shafton Road	Narrower path
Turn right at end into Shafton Road	
Continue straight on into Avenel Road	
Fork left at end up ramp to canal towpath	Dropped kerb needed on all canal path accesses Note footbridge over canal has stepped ramps, with the new accessible station footbridge being built, it would be a good time to replace this one
Turn left onto Forth & Clyde Canal towpath	
Turn 1st right across Blairdardie Road footbridge	Note how main line of towpath is sent around a very awkward corner just beyond footbridge which could be sorted by raising path to join closer to bridge
Turn left after bridge into Blairdardie Road	Outside shops
Turn right at end into Blairdardie Drive	Joining main road beyond shops
Turn right at mini-roundabout into Moraine Avenue	
Fork left at roundabout to continue along Moraine Avenue	
Turn 1st left into North Moraine Lane	Path in front of houses Dropped kerb needed
Turn 1st right into Essenside Avenue	Dropped kerbs needed at road crossing Path beyond railway bridge could be wider
Fork right at bend into path to Drumchapel Road	Dropped kerb needed – see photo Path could be wider
Continue straight on Kinfauns Road	Cross Drumchapel Road at traffic signals There are paths, apparently for the Drumchapel Way, but are not surfaced. Potential to increase accessibility if they were surfaced.
Turn left into Tallant Road	
Turn 1st left into Southdeen Avenue	

Fork left into Southdeen Play Area	Path through play area at bend near end of Southdeen Avenue
Fork left onto path to Drumchapel Sports Centre	At junction after play area Note all the potholes in the path
Turn right into Drumchapel Road	No Cycle Facilities
Negotiate Roundabout or use pedestrian crossing	To cross Duntreath Avenue
Continue on Drumry Road East and Finish	Return to start at Drumchapel Cycle Hub. Tour length 6.5miles
