

Councillor Ward Tour - Scotstoun

<i>Directions</i>	<i>Points to Note</i>
Start	Meet at Heart of Scotstoun Community Centre
Head north along Balmoral Street	
Continue straight on at traffic signals into Queen Victoria Drive	Cross Dumbarton Road at traffic signals
Turn left at traffic signals into Danes Drive	Note Danes Drive provides east-west route parallel to Dumbarton Road (and further east connects to Colleges Cycle Route in Broomhill), and route to Scotstoun Leisure Centre
Continue straight on into Eriska Avenue	
Fork right into Cairntoul Drive	Across Anniesland Road
Turn 1st left and right into Pennan Place	
Fork right into Kinellar Drive	
Turn right at roundabout into Craggan Drive	
Turn left at end into Dyke Road	
Turn 1st right into Speirshall Close	
U-turn at NCN Route 7 path connection	To follow proposed cycle route to Knightswood Park BMX park
Turn 1st left into Dyke Road	<i>(Proposed two-way cycle track then shared use footway past houses)</i>
Turn right at traffic signals into Alderman Road	Painted cycle lanes Note close proximity to parked cars with outwards opening doors
Turn left at traffic signals into Lincoln Avenue	<i>(Proposed shared use footway past houses then two-way cycle track)</i>
Turn left at traffic signals into Archerhill Road	<i>(Proposed two-way cycle track then shared use footway past houses)</i>
Turn 5th right into Bard Avenue	Proposed cycle route ends at Forth & Clyde Canal ahead Note signs for canal may be pointing in the wrong direction
Turn 1st left into Rampart Avenue	
Continue straight on into Glanderston Drive	

Fork right at end into Glanderston Drive (continued)	At Clarion Road junction
Turn right at end into Alderman Road	Painted cycle lanes Note close proximity to parked cars with outwards opening doors
Fork left at roundabout onto signed cycle path	At end of painted cycle lane on road
Fork right at end onto signed cycle path	Cross Kelso Street and use paving slab path Note danger of Kelso Street crossing being blocked by spillage from parking bays either side (could be built out for protection) Note barriers at Hawick Street end of path (discuss what they achieve)
Turn left at end into Hawick Street	
Fork right into Hawick Street (continued)	At Beil Drive junction Note "Recommended Route for Cycles" signs
Turn 2nd left into Hawick Street (continued)	At Dornal Avenue junction Note "End of Cycle Route" sign (Recommended Route signs continue along Dornal Avenue eastwards)
Continue straight on into Greenlaw Road	Cross Dumbarton Road
Continue straight on onto NCN Route 7 cycle path	
Continue straight on onto riverside path	See riverside and discuss new Yoker bridge
U-turn at riverside	
Turn 1st right onto NCN Route 7 cycle path	Note broken glass under bridges, lack of lighting
Continue straight on then left following NCN Route 7 cycle path	Cross Mellerstain Drive Note lack of street name signs along cycle path – places such as Edinburgh and Bristol sign each bridge or access point with name of street
Turn left into Ardsloy Place	After passing over Dumbarton Road
Turn left at end into Dumbarton Road	Peak hour bus lane Note general lack of cycle facilities on A814
Turn left at traffic signals into Burnham Road	
Turn left at end into South Street	
Turn 2nd left into Balmoral Street	
Finish	Tour approximately 7.5 miles, see http://cycle.travel/map/journey/53539
