**THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (BROOMHILL) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 201\_, GoBike Support with Proviso**

Thank you for your e-mail of 07 December and the opportunity to comment on your proposal to formalise the one way system on Edgehill Road from Woodcroft Avenue to Beechwood Drive further to the redevelopment of Broomhill Primary School.

GoBike has no objection to this proposal, provided that, in line with Glasgow City Council policy to increase active travel in the city, as per the Strategic Plan for Cycling 2016 – 2025 and Clause 5.1.5 of [Cycling by Design](#), one of your road infrastructure design guides, cycles are exempted and contraflow cycling is permitted.

If we are to improve the health of the general population of the city then increasing active travel, ie getting more of us walking and cycling, must be at the core of all proposals to change our infrastructure.

We look forward to your confirmation that contraflow cycling is to be permitted on Edgehill Road and that children, their parents and staff will thus be encouraged to cycle to the school.
