## PROPOSED FLAT TOP SPEED TABLES

East Dunbartonshire Council in terms of Section 37(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, hereby give notice of its intention to install two flat top speed tables on the junction of Newdyke Road and Newdyke Avenue, and the junction of Newdyke Road and Ivanhoe Drive, Kirkintilloch. The flat top speed tables will be constructed flush with existing road kerbs and ramped on all approaches. The construction of the speed table at the junction of Newdyke Road/Newdyke Avenue will, however, conflict with an existing nearby speed cushion on Newdyke Avenue and consequently this cushion will require to be removed. The removal of this speed cushion will have no impact on the existing reduced vehicle speeds in Newdyke Avenue.
