Thank you for your email of 08 March and the opportunity to comment on the proposals for restricting obstructive parking in the area around the new Health Centre at Woodside.

This is an urban, residential area where the majority of people visiting the Health Centre will be able to walk or cycle there, particularly if their route is clear of vehicles blocking either the footway or road crossing points.

It is essential that disabled people are able to park and that emergency vehicles have good access. Buses should also be able to stop at bus stops to allow people to embark and disembark safely.

GoBike strongly supports these proposals.
