



The Glasgow City Council
(B759 Cathkin Road)
(30mph Speed Limit) Order 20_

Report

The Council have been made aware of a potential road safety issue with the existing 40mph speed limit on the B759 Cathkin Road. This is due to a new housing development being built on this section of road which will increase the volume of local traffic.

Glasgow City Council's Local Transport Strategy includes a high level objective within Improving Road Safety. This is:-

- To improve the safety and the actual and perceived security of travelling within the City by reducing accidents and enhancing the personal security of all users of the transport network.

To achieve this objective the Council has agreed the following transport policy which is relevant to this proposal, as follows:-

- Continue with a holistic approach to road safety work, integrating engineering, education, enforcement, encouragement and evaluation.

The policy stated above can be achieved by:-

- Reducing the speed limit to 30mph around the access and egress point for the new Coulters Brae housing development.

Specifically, these proposals have been designed in line with the policies above and seek to contribute to achieving these objectives by:-

- Improving road safety by reducing the speed of vehicles travelling on the B759 Cathkin Road, which in turn, will make it safer for vehicles accessing and egressing the new Coulters Brae housing development.
