

### **Denmark Street (Traffic Regulation) Order 201\_**

Glasgow City Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

This Order will improve road safety and pedestrian safety by prohibiting obstructive parking practices and improving access to commercial properties particularly for larger vehicles.

The list of roads affected by these proposals are:

- Denmark Street

- No waiting and no loading/unloading at any time
