**THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL . (CITY CENTRE) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2010  
(VARIATION No25) (SOUTH CITY WAY) ORDER 201\_**

Thank you for your email of 26 June and the opportunity to comment on the proposals for preparation for the South City Way on Bridgegate and King Street.

We are delighted to see that the South City Way is approaching the city centre and we have no comments to make on the traffic management proposals. However, we are concerned at the lack of detail in your plans, particularly for the junctions.

The 2 significant junctions are that between Clyde Street and Bridgegate, immediately north of Victoria Bridge and that between Bridgegate and King Street. Your previous consultation covering Gorbals Street and Victoria Bridge gave no detail for the junction arrangements at the north end of the Victoria Bridge and you will be aware that GoBike has expressed serious misgivings about the junction design on the southern sections of the South City Way.

In respect of the junction between Bridgegate and King Street no details of the junction were available at the consultation in February and your design staff expressed the view that the junction design would be challenging.

It is critical that the designs are robust and that priority is given to people cycling at junctions with side streets such as Parnie Street.

When will the consultation on the detailed design take place? We look forward to hearing from you.
