Draft Local Transport Strategy

The Council has been working to produce a new Local Transport Strategy for the area, which will set out the Council's transport strategy, Transport Planning Objectives and a series of actions and interventions to enhance transport and travel across East Dunbartonshire.



The Draft Local Transport Strategy 2020-2025 was considered by the Council's Place, Neighbourhood and Corporate Assets Committee on 29 August 2019 and was approved for publication and consultation.

A period of consultation has been organised from 17 September to 12 November 2019, with a series of drop-in sessions being held.

The Council want to hear your final comments to help the Council in producing a final strategy for publication and implementation.
