## NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

## Sighthill (20mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 201

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Glasgow City Council are currently in the process of implementing Mandatory 20mph Speed Limit Zones throughout the City.

The purpose of the Mandatory 20mph Speed Limit Zone is to ensure that vehicle users reduce their speeds to 20mph or less, and therefore improve road safety for pedestrians, cyclists and all other vehicle users. By turn, it is anticipated that this will encourage more people to walk and cycle, which would have associated health benefits.

The list of roads affected by these proposals are: Cuddies, Campus Place, Fountainwell Drive,

Fountainwell Gardens, Fountainwell Grove,

Fountainwell Road, Hopepark Wynd, Hopepark Court, Huntingdon Street, Huntingdon Road, Huntingdon Close, Huttons Drive, Pinkston Road, Pinkston Drive, Pinkston Wynd, Sighthill Avenue, Sighthill Circus, Sighthill Park Gate, Sighthill Park Terrace, Stalk Court, Tower Place.

## Details of the proposals are as follows:

 This proposal would introduce a mandatory 20mph speed limit zone.
