London Road and Hamilton Road

(30mph Speed Limit) Order 202_

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The order proposes to implement a 30mph speed limit on London Road and Hamilton Road east of Mount Vernon Avenue.

THE LIST OF ROADS AFFECTED BY THESE PROPOSALS ARE:

Braidfauld Street, Carmyle Avenue, Causewayside Street, Hamilton Road, London Road.

DETAILS OF THE PROPOSALS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. 30mph speed limit London Road (currently 30mph west of Maukinfauld Road).
- 30mph speed limit Hamilton Road from 110 metres west of Mount Vernon Avenue to Roundknowe Road.
- 3. 30mph speed limit on Braidfauld Street.
- 4. 30mph speed limit on Carmyle Avenue.
- 5. 30mph speed limit on Causewayside Street.
