Report

1. Reason for Order

The purpose of this Order is to enable the provision of on carriageway cycle facilitates linking the existing South-West City Way to Pollok Country Park Therefore enabling safer and more sustainable travel options within this local.

2. Proposal

The main features of the proposals are:-

- Prohibition of waiting at anytime, together with prohibition of being in a two way cycle track on the south and East kerbline of St Andrews Drive from the Junction of Shields Road to the junction of Titwood Road.
- Corner / Junction protection on the North and West side of St Andrews Drive, no waiting for a distance of 10 metres from junction of the on the following roads, St Andrews Crescent Maxwell Drive

 Nithsdale Road Hamilton Avenue Sutherland Avenue Springkell Avenue Sherbrooke Ave Terregles Avenue Titwood Road, this will be in operation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

3. Expected outcome of the proposals

The outcome of these proposals shall be the enablement of the provision of a bidirectional segregated cycle route.
