## GENERAL WORKS UPDATE

There has been some challenging weather in the last few weeks with rain, wind, ice and snow but extra resources have been deployed to keep the project on track.

The main earth moving and forming of mounds for the play area at Toryglen Park is going well and several key paths are fully marked out and with foundations and kerbs starting to be installed.

Works in the community woodland have taken place to thin out certain areas and manage different habitats though most planting will be done during Spring.
