SCHEDULE 3 - ONE WAY OPERATION

Delete the item and replace with the following:

Hill Street westbound: 1 - from the extended west kerbline of Cambridge Street to the extended east kerbline of Dalhousie Street.

Hill Street westbound: 2 - from the extended west kerbline of Scott Street to the extended east kerbline of Garnet Street.

REASON FOR RESTRICTIONS

The above temporary changes to the existing one-way operation on Hill Street, Glasgow will allow for vehicles to travel in both directions from Scott Street to Dalhousie Street.

The Order will come into effect at 00:01 hours on Monday 26 April 2021 until 23:59 hours on Tuesday 30 November 2022.
