GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (HILL STREET) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021

Glasgow City Council has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -,

- 1) This Order may be cited as "Glasgow City Council (Hill Street) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2021" effect at 0001 hours on Monday 26 April 2021 until such times the order is revoked.
- 2) This order permits the use of Hill Street, Glasgow, from Scott Street to Dalhousie Street, to be used by vehicles to travel in both directions.

Order to be amended

Schedule 3 One Way Operation

Lengths of road within the City of Glasgow	Permitted Direction of Travel
Hill Street –Delete the item and replace with the following:- 1. From the extended west kerbline of Cambridge Street to the extended east kerbline of Dalhousie Street.	Westwards
From the extended west kerbline of Scott Street to the extended east kerbline of Garnet Street.	Westwards

The above temporary changes to the existing one way operation on Hill Street, Glasgow will allow for vehicles to travel in both directions from Scott Street to Dalhousie Street.

The Order will come into effect on 00:01 hours on Monday 26 April 2021 until 23:59 hours on 30 November 2022.
