NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

Burnfield Road (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202_

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

As part of the works associated with the new Bellway Homes housing development off Burnfield Road, a mandatory speed limit of 20mph is to be introduced to the area. This will reduce the mandatory speed limit from the existing 30mph to 20mph.

THE ROADS AFFECTED BY THESE PROPOSALS ARE GENERALLY BOUNDED BY

Burnfield Road to the north, Burnfield Cottages to the east, Sandstone Crescent to the south and Thornliebank Road to the west.

THE LIST OF ROADS AFFECTED BY THESE PROPOSALS ARE

Burnfield Cottages, Burnfield Road, Quarry Walk, Sandstone Crescent, Sandstone Drive, and an unnamed access road off Thornliebank Road.

DETAILS OF THE PROPOSALS ARE AS FOLLOWS

- The implementation of a mandatory 20mph speed limit zone
- Zone entry/exit signage; and
- '20' roundel road markings
