**GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL,  
AULHOUSE AREA (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 202\_**

Thank you for your email of 21 July and the opportunity to comment on the proposals for the control of motor vehicles in this residential area.

GoBike fully supports the measures proposed to prevent obstructive parking of motor vehicles and to improve access for residents.

However, we are concerned that you have made no mention of active travel and the potential for improving access for people who walk, wheel and/or cycle in this area. May we thus take it that conditions, particularly for people cycling, remain as they currently are, that is, with two-way cycle traffic retained on all streets and lanes? We consider it incumbent on you, in all proposals that affect road access, to maintain and improve cycling conditions, particularly in this year of COP26 in Glasgow, when the world is watching the city's green credentials.

Please confirm whether or not you have considered cycle traffic in your proposals. We would be grateful if you could do this in time for us to confirm or amend our response before the closing date of this consultation.
