Nitshill Road (40mph Speed Limit) (Amendment) Order 202

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

BACKGROUND TO THE PROPOSED ORDER

Due to a new development at a site on Nitshill Road, the existing 40mph speed limit and associated signage requires to be relocated eastward of its current position by a distance of 16 metres in order to allow the formation of the development access.

DETAILS OF THE PROPOSED ORDER

 Moving the existing 40mph speed limit restriction on the south side of Nitshill Road, eastwards by a distance of 16 metres.
