THE EAST DUNBARTONSHIRE COUNCIL (MAXWELL AVENUE AREA, BEARSDEN) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT ZONE) ORDER 2022

On 23 May 2022 the East Dunbartonshire Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 which comes into operation on Monday, 11 July 2022.

The proposed Order was advertised in the Milngavie and Bearsden Herald that was published on 15 November 2019. The main effect of the Order would be the introduction of 20 mph speed limit zone on Maxwell Avenue, Dirleton Gate, Wheatfield Road, Deepdene Road, Monreith Avenue, North View and Stirling Avenue, Bearsden, the lengths of which are described in the Schedule below, revoking an existing speed limit order on Maxwell Avenue as required.

A copy of the Order and plans detailing the lengths of road affected may be examined without payment of fee in the Roads section of the East Dunbartonshire Council website

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any provision therein on grounds that the Order is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any relevant Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 23 May 2022 make application to the Court of Session for this purpose.

The East Dunbartonshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 81 to 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The East Dunbartonshire Council (Maxwell Avenue Area, Bearsden) (20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on 11 July 2022.
- 2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-
 - "vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 mph on any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 5. The Order specified in Schedule 2 to this Order is hereby revoked

SCHEDULE 1

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Lengths of Road in Bearsden within East Dunbartonshire

Maxwell Avenue

 That length of Maxwell Avenue which extends from a point 39 metres or thereby south of the extended south kerbline of Canniesburn Road southeastwards for a distance of 1426 metres or thereby to a point 633 metres or thereby southeast of the extended south kerbline of Murrayfield Drive.

Monreith Avenue

- That length of Monreith Avenue which extends from the extended north kerbline of Maxwell Avenue westwards for a distance of 184 metres or thereby.
- That length of Monreith Avenue which extends from the extended north kerbline of Maxwell Avenue eastwards for a distance of 69 metres or thereby.

Stirling Avenue

 That length of Stirling Avenue which extends from the extended north kerbline of Maxwell Avenue northeastwards for distance of 307 metres or thereby to its termination, including the turning area.

North View

That length of North View which extends from the extended north kerbline
of Maxwell Avenue westwards and southwestwards for a distance of 225
metres or thereby to its termination.

Deepdene Road

That length of Deepdene Road which extends from the extended north kerbline of North View northwards for a distance of 354 metres or thereby to its termination, including the turning area.

Wheatfield Road

 That length of Wheatfield Road which extends from the extended north kerbline of Monreith Avenue northwards for a distance of 97 metres or thereby.

- That length of Wheatfield Road which extends from the extended north kerbline of Deepdene Road eastwards for a distance of 34 metres or thereby.
- That length of Wheatfield Road which extends from the extended north kerbline of Deepdene Road eastwards and southeatswards for a distance of 123 metres or thereby.
- 10.That length of Wheatfield Road which extends from the extended south kerbline of Dirleton Gate in a clockwise direction for a distance of 203 metres or thereby to the extended south kerbline of Dirleton Gate.

Dirleton Gate

- 11. That length of Dirleton Gate which extends from the extended south kerbline of Wheatfield Road eastwards for a distance of 31 metres or thereby.
- 12. That length of Dirleton Gate which extends from a point 62 metres or thereby south of the extended south kerbline of the east to west leg of Dirleton Gate northwards for a distance of 134 metres or thereby, including the turning areas.


